In 2022, we will deliver a variety of large and small local initiatives that will drive meaningful connections. These include cultural celebrations, community fundraising bbq for local groups, and ongoing collaboration with the local council.

#### **Customer Wellbeing**

As Westfield Tea Tree Plaza is an essential social and community hub in our local area, we are committed to ensuring it is safe, welcoming and inclusive. We do this by working closely with local authorities and emergency services and driving positive customer experiences in everything we do.

#### Sustainability

We are committed to reducing our carbon footprint and making it easier for our customers, retailers and staff to make environmentally conscious decisions. Supporting our retailers and customers to separate their waste has generated 285 tonnes of organic waste that was repurposed as garden compost and contributed to an overall landfill diversion of 82%.

#### **Community Site**

We provide a dedicated space at Westfield Tea Tree Plaza near Blackebys on level 1 for communityfocused groups to connect with people in the local area. This site is available to not-for-profit sports clubs, community groups, charities and welfare organisations to raise awareness of their work or to fundraise.
