

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR MISS/ MR NAIDOC VOTING PROGRAM 2022

1. VOTING PERIOD

1.1 .During the Voting Period: a. Westfield Plus members will vote for their preferred charity to receive the \$5000 grant. Voting is open to all Westfield Plus members, over the age of 18 years (Voter).

1.2 If a person under the age of 18 wishes to cast a vote, they may participate by having their parent or guardian cast a vote on their behalf.

1.3 Charities must not offer or provide any payment or other incentive or benefit to Voters to incentivise them to vote.

1.4 To cast a vote, the Voter must attend the centre (Westfield Carousel) in person, scan the appropriate QR code to register their vote, and collect a token from either the zone or concierge. (as applicable) and place a token in the box for their chosen charity.

1.5 Only votes which are cast during the Voting Period will be accepted by Scentre Group

1.6 A Voter may only vote for one charity per day (one vote per member per day)

2. VOTE COUNT

2.1 The count of public votes and determination of the successful Westfield Local Heroes will take place at Westfield Carousel, Albany Hwy Cannington, Perth, WA 6019

2.2. The results of the public vote will be determined by Scentre Group at its absolute discretion.

2.3. Scentre Group reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of votes, Voting Forms and Voters (including a Voter's identity) and to disqualify any vote that is not in accordance with the Terms and Conditions.

2.4. Scentre Group will not be responsible for any vote which is not counted due to any technical difficulties associated with the voting process

2.5. In the event of a tie, a representative of Scentre Group will determine the Westfield Local Hero in its absolute discretion, in consultation with the Perth Naidoc Program.

2.6. If any charity becomes ineligible to participate in the Program, the charity who has the next most number of votes will replace that ineligible charity and be given the donation of \$5000

2.7 Finalists must maintain the confidentiality of the results of the vote count (as advised by Scentre Group) until after public notification of the results or otherwise at Scentre Group's direction.

3. DONATION

3.1. In this Program, Scentre Group will give the charity with the most votes a selected by the public, the donation of \$5000 as from Westfield via the Perth Naidoc Program.

3.2. The relevant donation will be paid directly to the Perth Naidoc Program, as a registered business bank account and will not be paid directly into a charity or into a personal bank account.

3.3. Scentre Group reserves the right, at its absolute discretion, to request further information in relation to payment of the applicable Grant including to verify the bank account details provided by the Nominee or Affiliated Organisation or Group.

4. NOTIFICATION

4.1. Scentre Group will notify Perth Naidoc Program, and winning charity as between 11 and 30 July 2022 (Notification Period) in a manner to be determined by Scentre Group.

4.2 Winning Announcement will be made and fulfilled via the Perth Naidoc programs website or facebook page, and shared across Westfield Carousel channels accordingly.
